### 1.) Reservoir Dam Management Plan

  - i. Still exploring alternative ground water sources
  - ii. Looks like a 5-6 yr process
- City will provide quarterly updates on progress
- Still reviewing telemetry systems. Paul M. suggested we have someone speak to us about the pro's and con's of flow variations based on current mode of operation VS more real-time adjustments to water consumption. Maybe FWP presentation on impacts to fish habitat and habitat use patterns. Topic of future meeting maybe.
- Still considering extension of the Whitefish Lake intake pipe. Timing and budget unknown.

### 2.) Whitefish Municipal Watershed Project USFS

Michael shared the burn plan had been approved for next fall. Actual implementation
will be weather and condition dependent. Will likely take multiple years to implement.
Late September – early October burn window.

## 3.) Forest Plan Revision Update:

- 2 lawsuits have been filed on the new forest plan. Focus on grizzly bear, T&E and process claims.
- 4.) Replacement of Culverts on Haskill Basin County Road:
  - No progress. At an impasse.
- 5.) New Business:
  - Discussion of creek fencing on Haskill Creek. Landowner has been contacted by FCD, no violations.
